Want to get even more points for your school?

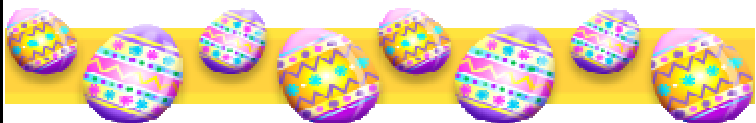
Spring is in the air and the *Labels for Education*sm program is helping your school's account bloom.

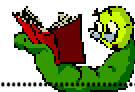
