Summer Assignments

MATH FACTS in a FLASH—

This past month the students in **grades 1 through 8** took a STAR Math test. Over the summer, students should use a computer and practice/test on levels of Basic Math Facts; Add, Subtract, Multiply and Divide. This program can be accessed through our school website-direct link. The student access code will be the same one they've used all year. They are separated into levels from level 1 up to level 40. The tests are 40 questions, 2-minute multiple-choice drills on these basic facts. Students advance by getting 100% correct on one level, then proceed to the next level. They will be rewarded for the number of levels they advance with N.U.T. days in the coming school year. The optimum number of levels for all 4 NUT days is 20 levels, the minimum number of levels they are required to do this summer is 5 levels.

N.U.T. Days for Math Facts In A Flash

5 levels mastered-- 1 N.U.T. Day

10 levels mastered-- 2 N.U.T. Day

15 levels mastered-- 3 N.U.T. Days

20 or more levels mastered-- 4 N.U.T. Days

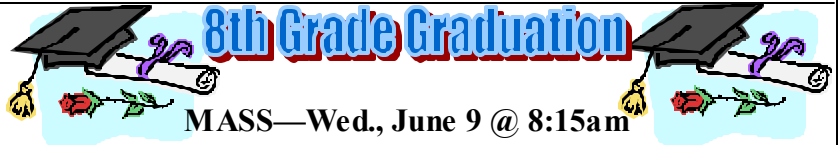
These N.U.T. Days will happen the week of September 13, 2010

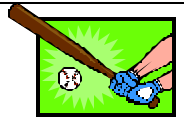

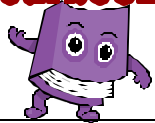
