

## STUDENT SUPPLY LIST GRADE 3

Dear Parents:

Your child will need the following supplies this year.

1. Book bag (**back packs with wheels are prohibited**)
2. Lunch box or lunch bag
3. Small drawstring bag for P.E. clothes
4. Art Box:  
Store inside: crayons, scissors, Elmer's glue or glue stick, ruler with inches and centimeters marked, and thin markers or colored pencils
5. Zippered pencil case (No pencil boxes, please)  
Store inside: 1 package of 24 yellow #2 pencils with erasers (sharpened, if possible)  
1 package red pens
6. 3 packages of lined notebook paper (**wide ruled only**)
7. 6 pocket folders with center clips. Please label:

10. 1 large box of Kleenex
11. 1 container of wet wipes
12. 2 wide-ruled spiral notebooks of 70 each to be used for spelling
13. \$6.00 for Seat Sack (you may use last year's seat sack if it's still in good shape).

Homework is assigned every night, except Friday. School notices will be sent home on Thursday.

## GRADE 5

Dear Parents:

Your child will need the following supplies for the year:

1. Pack of #2 pencils (replenish as necessary) **no mechanical pencils**
2. 1 red pen and 1 blue erasable pen (for checking/proofreading)
3. pen/pencil case (a soft zipper style - no plastic boxes, they do not fit in the desk).
4. 12" ruler with **easy to read** English and metric measures
5. compass- The thin metal ones often break, so you may want to look for the heavier plastic ones.
6. clear plastic protractor
7. paper - 1 pkg. of large graph paper and 2 pkgs. of looseleaf paper (wide rule)-please replenish as necessary
8. "My Homework Book" (**must be purchased from the school/ \$4.00**)
9. One plastic box for art supplies
10. colored pencils, crayons, scissors (good points), Elmer's glue, markers, 1 glue stick
11. \*eight (8) folders with pockets. Each folder should have sufficient loose leaf paper in it. Please have them labeled by the 1<sup>st</sup> day of school (see list at bottom). Include your name, too!
12. Book bag (**back packs with wheels are prohibited**)
13. Lunch box or bag , P.E. bag
14. 3 boxes of tissues
15. 2 rolls of paper towels, 1 box of bandaids and a container of disinfectant wipes (for student's personal use)

17. School sweater or sweatshirt (5<sup>th</sup> grade classroom is very cold. Please purchase one or the other from Sunshine Uniform Co.)
18. Pencil sharpener w/cover
19. highlighter
20. Eraser
21. Hand sanitizer (for student's personal use, replace as needed)
22. 1 pack of small index cards (31/2x5)
23. May use 1 large zippered binder to hold all folders
