Fingerprinting



All parents are required to do 20 hours of volunteer work every year. In order to start, you must be fingerprinted through the Diocese.

To begin the fingerprint process, go to the diocesan website:
www.orlandodiocese.org

Then go to the Safe Environment Link provided to watch the Safe Environment Video and take the test at the end of the video. You must then register online on the link provided:

www.Fieldprintflorida.com

to make an appointment to get your fingerprints done at one of the locations listed.

When asked for your **Fieldprint Code**, please make sure to use the correct one for St. Peter School Volunteers:

New fingerprinting costs—Volunteers: \$44.00; Employees/Clergy: \$51.25
