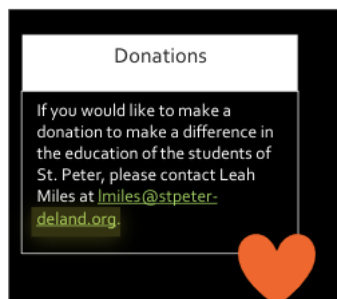
IN THIS ISSUE
